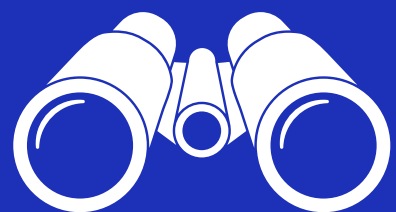


MARINE ANIMAL INTERACTIONS CODE OF CONDUCT

Keep a lookout for marine animals



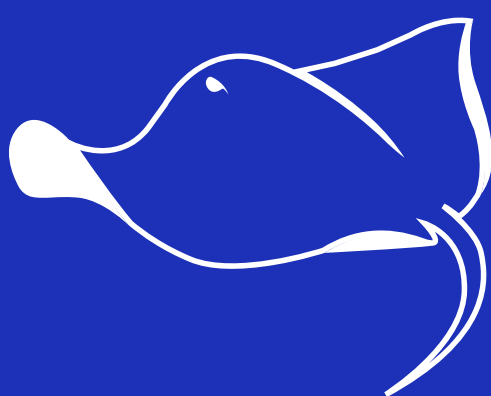
Don't chase or harass wildlife



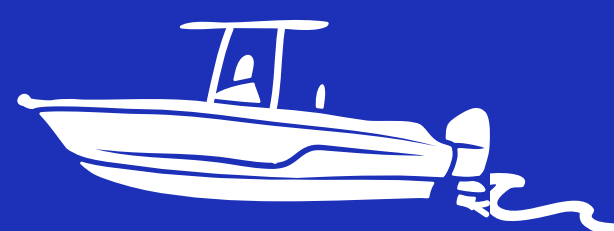
Don't touch or feed wildlife



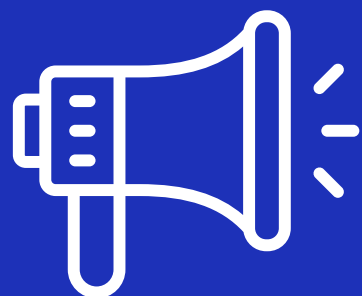
Avoid sudden movements or crowding the animal



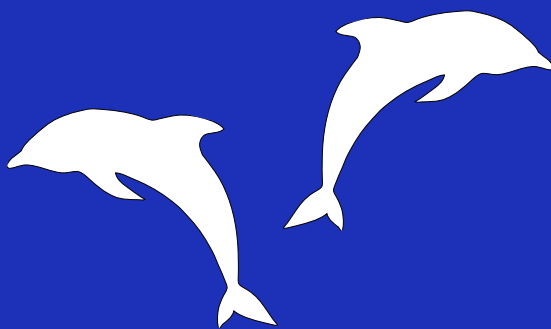
Move away if the animal changes behaviour



Limit the time spent with an animal



Avoid loud noises or sounds to try & attract animals



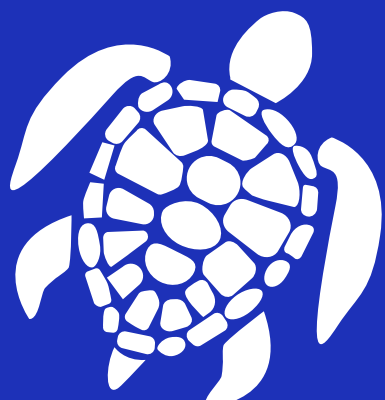
Avoid separating a group of animals
